- WHAT IS IT?** - A research project to identify new connections between conservation practices, soil health, and water quality.
- WHO IS IT FOR?** - We are looking for Michigan growers in Lenawee, Hillsdale and Monroe counties to help us further understand the link between soil health and water quality.
- WHAT WE NEED FROM YOU?** - Access to 1 to 2 fields for soil sampling and a one-hour interview to discuss management history on sampled fields.
- CRITERIA FOR PARTICIPATION** - We estimate about an hour to collect five years of field management information on crop rotation, yield, nutrient applications, and other practices that will help us understand nutrient cycling and whether N and P are applied in deficit or excess of crop demand.
- BENEFITS OF PARTICIPATION** - \$1000 for completion of soil sampling and interview, detailed soil health test results, and estimates of N and P use efficiency.
